Uttarakhand's Adventure Sports Tableau Selected for Republic Day Parade 2025

Dehradun: The Government of India has selected Uttarakhand's "Adventure Sports" tableau to be featured in the Republic Day Parade 2025, scheduled to take place in New Delhi.

The announcement follows a detailed selection process involving proposals from 34 states and union territories. The tableau of Uttarakhand was reviewed by an Expert Committee set up by the Ministry of Defence, with the final decision being communicated in a letter dated December 21, 2024. The central and rear sections of the tableau will showcase the state's prominent adventure sports, including rock climbing, paragliding, bungee jumping, hill cycling, trekking, river rafting, skiing in Auli, and zip-lining and rock climbing in Rishikesh.
