Jurassic World approved in Bangkok

The Board of Investment (BoI) has approved an investment project to build Jurassic World, a new Bangkok-based attraction featuring animatronic dinosaurs, to promote tourism. The 1.2-billion-baht project, spanning 4,000 square metres, is set to be located in Asiatique The Riverfront, an open-air mall on the banks of the Chao Phraya River. Asset World Attraction and Retail, a subsidiary of Asset World Corp (AWC), received the green light from the Bol to push ahead with the investment. The project, named Jurassic World: The Experience, is the first of its kind in Southeast Asia." The company wants to develop this tourist attraction into a new landmark for Bangkok and Thailand," said Narit Therdsteerasukdi, Secretary-general of the Bol.

New York's Seneca Park Zoo unveils \$100m expansion plan

The Seneca Park Zoo in Rochester, New York is set to undergo a \$100 million expansion, and has selected CambridgeSeven as the project architect. The expansion will add two new structures to the Seneca Park Zoo - a tropics exhibit and a main entry building, both inspired by the adjacent Genesee river valley. CambridgeSeven has more than 60 years' experience in the master planning and design of animal habitats and aquaria. The firm was selected in a design competition. Its plan for the new exhibit and welcome building includes sustainable materials, native plantings, and sensitive scale and siting.
