Adventure zone to come up at Eco-Hill Park in Hyderabad

HYDERABAD: The Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA) is set to introduce an 'adventure zone' at the Eco-Hill Park in Kothwalguda near Himayatsagar Reservoir. Spread across 6.04 acres within the park's 82-acre expanse, this new attraction will offer visitors an array of adventure activities while ensuring safety. The proposed facility will feature activities such as a sky bridge, roller coaster zip line, climbing wall, giant swing, suspension bridge, flying cup, human slingshot, zipline, zip bike (at least two lines), 360-degree flying cycle, rope course with multiple obstacles, bungee trampoline, and other activities like vortex tunnels and rifle shooting. The estimated cost of the . project is Rs 15 crore.

Cabinet approves Kedarnath ropeway project

The Cabinet approved ropeway projects between Sonprayag and Kedarnath, and Govindghat and Hemkund Sahib Ji under Parvatmala Pariyojana. The 12.9 km and 12.4 km ropeways in the state of Uttarakhand have been given the nod for Rs 4,081.28 crore and Rs 2,730.13 crore respectively. Both the projects are expected to create substantial employment opportunities during construction and operation phases, as well as in related tourism sectors like hospitality, travel, food & beverages, and tourism throughout the year.
