

Delhi scraps police clearance mandate for hotels, pools and gaming zones

In a recent move, the Delhi government has eliminated the long-standing mandate that compelled companies in the hospitality and entertainment industries to acquire a No Objection Certificate (NOC) or licence from Delhi Police, all as part of a significant regulatory revamp. This is a massive change in the way the checks and balances as well as functions of enterprises including hotels, restaurants, guest homes, motels, discotheques, auditoriums, swimming pools, amusement parks, and video game parlours are governed. All in all, it is soon anticipated that the action will simplify corporate processes, cut down on bureaucracy, and free up police resources. The police body, however, has reservations of their own around matters of law and order which is their duty around these spaces.


CIDCO revives plan to develop Nhava Island into a tourism hub

The Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation (MTDC) revived its plan to create a tourism zone on Mumbai's western shore. The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) is the special planning authority of the Manori-Gorai-Uttan area, which has permitted MTDC to establish an amusement-cum-water park and allied facilities on 100 acres of land at Gorai. Among the plans being explored are hotels, resorts, restaurants, convention centres, curated parks or forests, residential real estate, theme parks etc.

DreamPark: world's largest XR theme park gets Seattle venue

Mixed reality (XR) developer DreamPark is opening a new location in Seattle this weekend, as part of its plans to build the world's largest XR theme park. DreamPark transforms ordinary spaces into immersive experiences, overlaying digital worlds onto physical environments through a network of access points, or physical markers like QR codes. These digital worlds are accessible via Meta Quest headsets or mobile devices. The Seattle space, a 25,000-square-foot XR attraction, is opened to Public on 19 July at West Canal Yards, DreamPark has announced.
