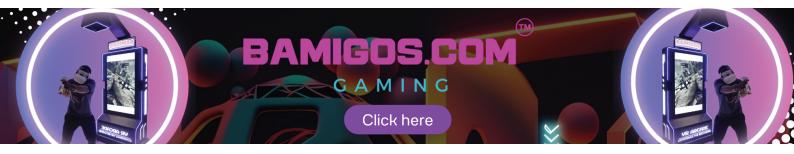


Ingka Centres partners PVR-Inox to open 9-screen cinema in Gurugram retail centre

Ingka Centres, Ikea parent Ingka Group's shopping centre division, and cinema chain PVR-Inox on Tuesday announced the signing of a partnership to set up a nine-screen movie theatre within the upcoming Ingka Centre in Gurugram. Ingka Group, which also comprises Ikea Retail and Ingka Investments, unveiled plans for the Gurugram centre last year, allocating a total investment of approximately €400 million (₹3,500 crore) for the mixed-use development, slated to open in late 2025 The Gurugram centre will feature various retail formats, workspaces, and community event spaces, with an expected annual visitor count of 20 million.

India's First Undersea Tunnels in Mumbai

The undersea twin tunnels in South Mumbai, which are part of the Rs 12,721-crore Mumbai Coastal Road Project, are nearing completion and are set to open by November 2023, marking India's first undersea tunnel. The construction of the 2.07-kilometer tunnels near Girgaon, proceeding north under the Arabian Sea, Girgaon Chowpatty, and Malabar Hill, and concluding at Breach Candy's Priyadarshini Park involved cutting through complex geological strata by 35 men and a massive Chinese Tunnel Boring Machine for over two years.
