Delhi is going to have 10 new theme parks for children. Those will be infused with interactive play structures like robots, animal replicas and science models. The Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), with its innovative playgrounds, aims to sprinkle fun across various zones.

In 2018, the MCD introduced "Nandan Van" at Greater Kailash-1, a pioneer in blending cartoon and animal themes into play areas. This venture, costing around ₹1 crore, set the precedent for what's now a city-wide initiative to craft at least one such magical space in every administrative zone. The parks won't be just playgrounds. Those will offer adventure and learning.

Saudi Arabia's Qiddiya unveils immersive F1 circuit

Saudi Arabia's Qiddiya has unveiled a new motorsport circuit where Formula 1 drivers will race past the giga-project's theme parks and immersive attractions.Designed to be a future venue for the Saudi Arabian Grand Prix, an F1 motor racing event, the new track is located in the Qiddiya City destination for entertainment, sports and culture. Called Speed Park Track, it will sit at the centre of an area dedicated to motorsports, and will boast some of racing's most recognisable track design features, Qiddiya said. Designed by Austrian former F1 driver Alex Wurz and German circuit designer Hermann Tilke, the racetrack features 21 corners and a unique elevated first corner called Blade, which rises more than 20 storeys above the ground.
