Wonders Park to reopen from Dec 15 with ₹27 crore facelift

Situated at sector 19-A in Nerul, the park is spread across a 9.8-hectare plot and was built at ₹37.34 crore in 2012. The park has models built on the theme of Seven Wonders of the World along with rides like a frisbee ride, octopus ride, ferris wheel ride and break dance ride along with a toy train that chugs around the entire park.

The corporation has spent ₹27 crore to give a new avatar to the amusement park, for example, it has added five new rides and a musical fountain in the park.


These five rides have been replaced with six new rides namely, the sky wheel ride, sky copter ride, rocking disc, sky swinger, worm coaster and bumper car ride. A musical fountain, powered by 28 pumps, will also be added, but will only start functioning by January end. The musical fountain, for which ₹8.09 crore has been spent, will be placed in front of the existing amphitheatre.

India's first-ever 'Night Sky Sanctuary' to be ready by year-end in Ladakh

The work on India's first-ever 'Night Sky Sanctuary' in Ladakh's Hanle is going on in full swing and is expected to be complete in over a month's time.

The sanctuary, being set up by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) under the Ministry of Science and Technology, will attract tourists from across the world to picturesque Ladakh and also boost astro-tourism in the region. The Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC), the Indian Institute of Astrophysics (IIA), and the UT administration have signed a tripartite MoU for launching the Dark Space Reserve. The site will have activities to boost local tourism and the economy through interventions of science and technology.







Michigan's largest indoor water park coming to Bavarian Inn Lodge

The \$80m expansion will add more than 20 new aquatic attractions. Michigan's largest indoor water park is coming to the Bavarian Inn Lodge, part of a German-themed resort in Frankenmuth.

The \$80 million expansion will add more than 100,000 square feet to the resort's indoor water park. The water park will feature more than 20 new aquatic attractions, including waterslides and a wave pool. The general contractor for the expansion is R.C. Hendrick & Son, Inc. The Bavarian Inn Lodge says the project will create Michigan's largest indoor water park and family entertainment center at more than 140,000 square feet.
