PM Modi inaugurates 5-star Gandhinagar station, new attractions in Ahmedabad Science City

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday, 16 July 2021, virtually inaugurated the redeveloped railway station in Gujarat's capital Gandhinagar and a five star hotel above it. In Ahmedabad, he inaugurated a nature park, an aquatic gallery and robotic gallery at the Science City.

The aquatic gallery, spread over 15,000 square meters, will be the largest aquarium in India housing 68 tanks showcasing 188 marine species, including penguins. A key attraction is a 28 metre long unique walkway tunnel. The project has been developed in collaboration with Marine Scape Eo-aquarium, New Zealand.

Chhattisgarh: Abandoned Durg mine to be site of India's biggest man-made forest

India's biggest man-made forest will come up on 885 acres of land in a mined out area over the next three years at an estimated cost of Rs 3 crore in Chhattisgarh's Durg district, officials said. The project, which will come up at the abandoned Nandini limestone site under the supervision of the district administration, will present an example to the world as to how mined out areas can be converted into natural habitats, they said.

"The project is being carried out on the direction of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel. The mine used to supply limestone to SAIL NSE 0.32 %'s Bhilai Steel Plant but has been lying abandoned for the last few years. Forest cover in the Nandini area used to be around 17 kilometres before mining started. Now 80,000 trees will be planted on 885 acres of land. Funds will come from the District Mineral Foundation," a state government public relations department official said.

Paramount Pictures creating Southeast Asia's biggest theme park in Bali

Paramount Pictures has signed an agreement with an Indonesian company to create a theme park in the Jembrana regency of Bali. Paramount Pictures is developing the biggest theme park in Southeast Asia, located in the Jembrana regency of Bali, alongside Indonesian company PT Kios Ria Kreasi.

In a press release issued by the People's Consultative Assembly, speaker Bambang Soesatyo said the project will strengthen Bali's post-COVID economy. "The development of Paramount theme park will strengthen Bali's position as a recreational and entertainment hub for world citizens," Bambang said.



The agreement was signed last week in Los Angeles, with the event virtually attended by Indonesian officials including Wayan Koster, the governor of Bali.The Paramount Pictures attraction will be located in Pekutatan, Jembrana. It is expected to soft launch in 2025 and will attract up to 5 million annual visitors.
