

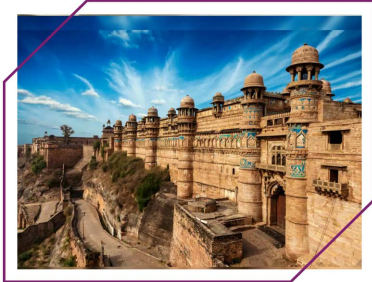

Tourism Projects Entitled for Capital Subsidy

Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board also referred to as the 'MPTB' was established in 2017 with an objective to promote tourism in Madhya Pradesh. Development of tourism with public, private partnership in sustainable manner, investor facilitation, skill-development, publicity/promotion of tourist destinations nationally & internationally, identification and development of tourism infrastructure are the core objectives of the Board.



Tourism Projects established and operationalised during the operative tenure of this policy shall be entitled to capital investment subsidy. Considering to the type of activity and the capital investment, capital subsidy shall be granted as mentioned below:

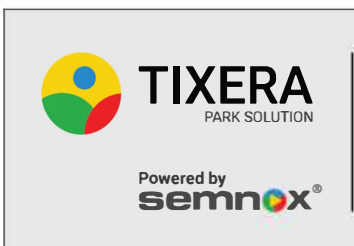

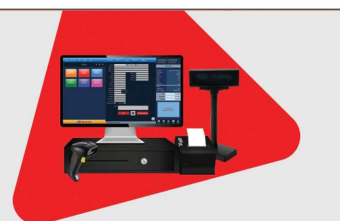

Centre executing projects worth Rs 1,34,200 crore to boost rail, road, air network in Northeast

Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said the Centre is implementing various rail, road and air connectivity projects worth Rs 1,34,200 crore in the northeast. Addressing the 'Natural Allies in Development and Interdependence' conclave here, she said the Union government has been pumping in huge money in developing a number of infrastructure projects throughout the region.

"We are carrying out 20 railway projects worth Rs 74,000 crore for 2,011 km, which are spread across the northeast," Sitharaman said. The Centre is also developing 4,000 km of roads in the region at a total cost of Rs 58,000 crore, she added.

The Ministry of Tourism, Govt of India, in partnership with United Environment Program (UNEP) and Responsible Tourism Society of India (RTSOI) organized National Summit on Developing Sustainable & Responsible Tourist Destinations in New Delhi. On the occasion, the Ministry launched the National Strategy for Sustainable Tourism and Responsible Traveller Campaign. The Strategy document has identified the strategic pillars for development of sustainable tourism like Promoting Environmental Sustainability, Protecting Biodiversity, Promoting Economic Sustainability, Promoting Socio-Cultural Sustainability, Scheme for Certification of Sustainable Tourism, IEC and Capacity Building and Governance.



Speaking on the occasion Secretary Tourism Arvind Singh said that Tourism and Environment share a Special Relationship. Prime Minister has also announced that India will increase its capacity of non-fossil energy capacity to 500 GW and meet 50 per cent of its energy requirements through renewable energy by 2030.

Disney's new Princess and the Frog attraction to open in 2024



Disney's new attraction inspired by The Princess and the Frog is set to open at Walt Disney World and Disneyland in 2024, according to Tiana voice actress Anika Noni Rose. The Tiana-themed attraction will replace Splash Mountain at both Magic Kingdom in Florida and Disneyland in California.

Rose is working alongside Disney's creative team on the reimagined ride, which will remove elements from 1946's Song of the South. The film has been accused of perpetuating racist stereotypes. "They are making a ride - it'll be out in 2024," Rose confirmed on Live With Kelly and Ryan (via Entertainment Weekly).

According to a Disney spokesperson, the "timing has not been determined" for opening the ride (via Spectrum News). "We look forward to sharing more details during Essence Festival of Culture in New Orleans in July," the spokesperson said.

Saudi Arabia to Debut Its First Water-Themed Park
