Creating Switzerland In India: Swiss Level Ropeway, Railway Expansion Planned In Uttarakhand

Railway Minister Piyush Goyal on Tuesday (23 February) said his ministry will conduct a study to expand the railway and ropeway network in Uttarakhand on the lines of Switzerland, reports Financial Express. Uttarakhand Chief Minister Trivendra Singh Rawat was given this assurance by the minister during a meeting held recently.

The minister approved the final location survey of the Tanakpur-Bageshwar rail line. He also directed the officials to take immediate steps for doubling of the Haridwar - Raiwala section and introduction of direct train service between

Dehradun and Rishikesh. The Modi government has undertaken many infrastructure projects in the hill state of Uttarakhand to improve connectivity andboost the tourism sector.

The government also plans to launch a seaplane service between Delhi and Uttarakhand's Tehri.
