#### Bengaluru's Wonderla Holidays re-opened for public from 13 November 2020

The park will be open only on Fridays to Sundays at a reopening price of ₹699. The company also added that the park will exclusively be open only for over 12,000 frontline COVID-19 warriors starting November 9, 2020 until November 12, 2020.

"In order to follow social distancing protocols and to maintain a contactless system, the entry into the amusement park will only be permitted through online booking," it said.

As a crowd control measure, the theme park's capacity will be restricted to three thousand per day. The water park is to remain closed initially as per government guidelines.

Assam's Kaziranga National Park and Tiger Reserve (KNPTR) reopened for tourists from 21st October 2020, after a gap of over seven months. It was shut down in March because of the coronavirus disease (Covid-19) outbreak...

Following the Covid-19 outbreak, all five national parks and 18 wildlife sanctuar ies in Assam, including KNPTR, which usually remains shut for around five months annually due to floods, were closed in March. The state government has prepared detailed protocols in the wake of Covid-19. All tourists will have to go through a screening process and anyone detected with disease-related symptoms such as high fever, cough and cold will be segregated and handed over to local health authorities.

#### EsselWorld HoneyBee Habitat Conservation launched

Known for its lush green surroundings, EsselWorld has more than 2 lakh trees and plants of different species which has become an eco-system for various birds, insects, bees and butterflies. Keeping the flora and fauna of the Park in mind, EsselWorld initiated the concept of Bee Farming known as EsselWorld HoneyBee Habitat Conservation under the leadership of Flt. Lt. Mr. Anand Lamdhade, (Retd), Sr. Vice President- Operations & New Projects, EsselWorld & Water Kingdom.

Launched on 5th November 2020, the Honey Bee colonies have an influence at a stretch of 3-4 kms that house about 1.2 lakh honey bees comprising of 10 families of Sateri bees and 1 family of Trigona Bees.

Each of the bee families are stored in different boxes and are being nurtured under the guidance and consultation of an expert Apiculturist. Understanding the importance of bio-diversity and nature conservation, EsselWorld initiated this concept and are ensuring more and more bees are being conserved.
