
Lulu Group to invest Rs 3,000 cr to set up India's biggest mall at Ahmedabad

UAE-based billionaire Yussuf Ali's Lulu Group International is entering Gujarat, where it would invest Rs 3,000 crore to set up India's biggest shopping mall at Ahmedabad, a company official said. The construction of the Rs 3,000-crore shopping mall, which would have all modern facilities, will start early next year, said Lulu Group Director of Marketing and Communications V Nandakumar.

This would be Lulu Group's third shopping mall in the country after Kochi, (Kerala) and Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh), and provide direct employment to 6,000 people and indirect employment to over 12,000 in the state, he added. The Ahmedabad-based shopping mall will have over 300 national and international brands, a 3,000-people capacity food court with multi-cuisine restaurants, 15-screen multiplex cinemas with Imax, India's biggest children's amusement centre and many other attractions.

Reliance Industries to open country's first multi-disciplinary cultural centre in Mumbai

Reliance Industries (RIL) on October 6 announced it will open India's first multi-disciplinary cultural centre - the Nita Mukesh Ambani Cultural Centre (NMACC)-- in Mumbai's Bandra Kurla Complex on March 31, 2023.

NMACC is housed within the recently-launched Jio World Centre. The three-storeyed building will open spaces for performing as well as visual arts, Reliance Retail, which is a subsidiary of Reliance Industries, said in the press release. The centre will also launch the Art House, four-storeyed space spotlighting leading Indian and international artists.

On March 31, 2023, NMACC will be opened with a host of activities planned in its three-day launch event, the statement said.

India's longest train route covers over 4,000 kms travelling via 9 states

Indian Railways are undoubtedly the lifeline of India as it connects almost every state from north-south. This rail network has connected the most remote areas to major metropolitan cities of India. From bridging the gap between north and south to east and west, Indian Railways has covered to Tamil Nadu. Vivek Express train covers the longest distance of 4,150 kilometres connecting Assam to Tamil Nadu. Vivek Express train covers the longest train route of Indian Railways in six days, by starting its train journey from Assam's Dibrugarh and reaching Tamil Nadu's Kanyakumari in approximately 74-79 hours.

During its journey, the Vivek Express running from Dibrugarh to Kanyakumari crosses a total of 9 states and has 58 halts en route its journey.

Japan's Ghibli Park unveils lands and attractions ahead of opening

Ahead of the imminent opening of Japan's new Studio Ghibli theme park on 1 November, Ghibli Park is teasing its themed lands and attractions. The first three themed areas, Ghibli's Grand Warehouse, Dondoko Forest and Hill of Youth, are preparing to open to the public. Mononoke Village and Valley of Witches will launch later in fall 2023 and March 2024.

The \$323 million attraction is located in the Expo 2005 Aichi Commemorative Park. Aichi expects to welcome around 1.8 million visitors each year once all five areas are open. Ghibli Park is based on anime films including My Neighbor Totoro, Kiki's Delivery Service, Spirited Away, Castle in the Sky,

Gigantosaurus Land will open at ROARR! in 2024 and will include a vertical volcano-themed drop ride, spinning flower teacups, water play, a jumping pillow, a towering wooden play 'n' climb den and more.

The land has been designed to encourage exploratory and sensory family play, and there will also be several interactive attractions for families to experience together.

The water park will also offer an enhanced holiday atmosphere, according to a release. Festive treats, snowfall and a tropical Santa are available through 31 December.

Blizzard Beach boasts various attractions, from waterslides to rapids and pools. Summit Plummet is one of the tallest and fastest freefall body slides, while Teamboat Springs is one of the world's longest group whitewater raft adventures.
